A Project Rooted in Purpose, Community, and Wellbeing

Clifton Terrace School, nestled in the heart of Atawhai, is a cornerstone of our community. One of Nelson's oldest schools, it celebrated its centennial in 1959, with deep generational roots still visible today. Many of the original families remain in the area, contributing to a proud, vibrant culture that stretches across decades.

Today, we are home to 285 tamariki ranging in age from five to eleven — curious, energetic, diverse learners who are growing up in a world that's changing faster than ever. And just as the world evolves, so too must the spaces in which our children learn.

We are reaching out to our community, local businesses, and education advocates to raise **\$60,000** to transform an underused space into a vibrant, **nature-connected outdoor classroom and calm zone**. We need your help to bring this vital project to life by the end of 2025.

Why We Need This Space: A Safe Haven in a Busy World

Modern schools are full of stimulation — constant movement, sound, and activity. While many children thrive in active settings, not all do. Increasingly, our students include those who:

- Experience sensory overload
- Have neurodiverse needs (ADHD, autism, anxiety)
- Come from trauma backgrounds
- Simply need a quiet, reflective space to recharge

Currently, the only place children can find peace is **indoors** — in the library or tucked away in quiet corners. But our vision is bigger than that. We want children to find calm and focus **in nature**, not behind four walls.

"Sometimes I just want to read outside without all the noise. I don't want to go back inside when it's sunny."

This outdoor classroom will provide exactly that — a natural, shaded, inclusive space that welcomes every learner, including those who need stillness to succeed.

Backed by Research: Nature as a Teacher and Healer

Educational research and neuroscience tell us what indigenous knowledge has always known:

- Time in nature **reduces stress and anxiety**
- Outdoor learning improves **focus, emotional regulation, and creativity**
- Calm, sensory-friendly environments benefit **all children**, especially those with learning differences

By creating a sensory-sensitive outdoor learning area, we're not just meeting educational needs — we're investing in lifelong wellbeing.

Our Vision: Expanding Horizons, Together

Our school vision is to **expand every child's horizon**. We see this in the godwit that travels vast distances, and in the Boulder Bank that holds our estuary together — unique natural metaphors that inspire us to build strength, courage, and curiosity in our tamariki.

Our outdoor classroom, designed with input from students, staff, and leading landscape architects Boffa Miskell, reflects this vision:

- **A central learning and gathering hub** in the heart of our school
- A space for outdoor teaching, performances, quiet time, and reflection
- **Integrated shade, natural planting, and safe visibility** across all areas
- Strong connections to our green spaces, mountain bike track, and playing fields

It's more than a classroom. It's a **living, breathing space** that supports every type of learner and further strengthens our school culture.

Terms & Conditions



1. The Promotion is the Clifton Terrace School Home and School Committee 60 Second Grocery Grab (**Promotion**).
2. The Promotor of this prize draw is Clifton Terrace School Home and School Committee (**Promotor**) in partnership with Four Square Atawhai.
3. The prize draw is being run at Four Square Atawhai in the South Island only.
4. By entering this Promotion you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The Promoter reserves the right to deem that your entry is void should you fail to comply with any of these Terms and Conditions.

Promotion Period

5. The prize draw entry period will commence on 20/05/2025 and will run until 19/06/2025.

Prize and Mechanics

6. The prize winner will be drawn and notified by 26/06/2025 by Clifton Terrace School Home and School Committee. The prize draw will be held on 26/06/2025 by Clifton Terrace School Home and School Committee by random selection from all eligible entries made during the Promotion Period
7. Prize is:
 - a. The first eligible entry drawn will win one 60 Second 'Grocery Grab' at the Participating Store, valued at a maximum of \$1000.00 (including GST).
 - b. The Grocery Grab will take place at Four Square Atawhai at a time that is suitable for both parties (Winner/The Store). The prize winner and Four Square Atawhai will work together in good faith to mutually agree a time to complete the Grocery Grab outside of the Participating Store's trading hours, however, the time of the Grocery Grab shall ultimately be decided at the sole discretion of the Participating store. If a prize winner is unable to make the agreed time, or does not show up, a further draw may be conducted, and the prize allocated to a new winner.
 - c. If the winner is unable to attend the Grocery Grab, they can transfer it to a person of their choice (subject to eligibility conditions).
 - d. The winner will get a maximum of 60 seconds on the agreed time and date with one trolley to collect as many groceries as possible to maximum value of \$1000.00 (including GST).
 - e. Only one person can partake in the Grocery Grab prize.
 - f. The winner cannot grab more than 4 of the same product/item; different flavours or varieties of the same range/brand may be accepted.
 - g. All items must be hand-picked, and shelves cannot be swept with their arms.
 - h. The Grocery Grab excludes all Tobacco, Alcohol, Electronics, Gift Cards, Phone Cards, Cosmetics, New Zealand Lotteries tickets and Pharmacy Items. If a prize winner selects products that are not eligible as part of the Grocery Grab the winner will not be permitted to keep these products, and they will not contribute toward the total prize value.
 - i. The total trolley of groceries will be calculated at the checkout. If the value exceeds \$1000.00 (including GST), the winner will have the choice of what they would like to put back or to pay the difference if they decide to keep the product. If the value is less than \$1000.00 (including GST) worth of groceries by the end of the 60 second period, any remaining balance will be forfeited and the participants Grocery Grab completed; any shortfall cannot be claimed in goods or cash.
 - j. Groceries won in the grocery grab aren't for resale, and are strictly for personal use.
 - k. Employees of Four Square Atawhai and Clifton Terrace School are not eligible for entry.
 - l. This prize is not exchangeable, negotiable or redeemable for cash.
8. The winner will be notified via Phone. If a winner cannot be contacted within 48 hours of the draw, the prize will be forfeited, and another winner will be drawn from eligible entries.

Method of Entry

9. To enter the prize draw, purchase a \$5.00 raffle ticket at Four Square Atawhai or Clifton Terrace School and complete the details on raffle ticket.
10. Incomplete or invalid entries or those not submitted in accordance with the entry instructions will not be accepted. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries.
11. You must be a NZ resident and 18+ to enter. Winners who do not have a valid identification will not be eligible and the prize will be redrawn.

The time entries are deemed to be made, will be the time the entry is received, not the time the entry is submitted by an entrant.
14. Promotor is not responsible if a winner cannot be contacted following the draw due to incorrect or out of date contact details being provided, and any such winner will forfeit the prize to the next eligible winner, on these Terms and Conditions

Conditions
